Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.212 dated 01.10.2017, under Sections 406, 420 IPC and Section 24 of the Immigration Act, 1983, registered at Police Station, City Kharar, SAS Nagar and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Vide order dated 25.11.2019, learned State counsel was directed to find out the status of investigation in the subject FIR. In response to the said order, status report by way of affidavit of Pall Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Kharar-I has been filed, wherein it is stated that during the course of investigation, statements of the witnesses were recorded and the related record of the bank was taken into possession. A notice under Section 41A Cr.P.C. was issued to the petitioner to join investigation, but he did not come. During investigation,

petitioner approached the Sessions Court for grant of anticipatory bail, which was dismissed on 29.01.2019 and at present he is in judicial custody.

It is also mentioned that a complaint dated 15.07.2019 has been received from the wife of the petitioner pleading his false implication in the said FIR, in which inquiry is being conducted.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press this petition at this stage.

Dismissed as not pressed.
