Petitioner, who claims to be working on the post of Assistant Professor (Mathematics) under the Beant College of Engineering & Technology, Gurdaspur, seeks a Mandamus for directing the respondents to grant to her the benefit of regularization in service.

Pleadings on record are wholly insufficient as regards demonstrating that the petitioner is eligible to seek regularization under any regularization policy/instructions that may have been issued by the competent authority. Even the appointment letter has not been placed on record. It is not even discernible from the averments made in the petition as to whether the initial engagement of the petitioner in the year 2013 as is being claimed was pursuant to any regular selection process.

In the absence of the necessary pleadings as also material, the claim of the petitioner cannot be gone into.

Petition is dismissed.
