The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners, in case FIR No. 283, dated 23.08.2019, under Sections 323, 324, 147, 148, 149 and 354 of IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 39, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to order dated 28.11.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation. This fact is not disputed by the counsel for the State as well.
