This petition has been filed by the wife seeking transfer of a petition filed by her husband under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, titled as "Jagroop Singh v. Hardeep Kaur" from the Court of Civil Judge (Senior Division), Sri Muktsar Sahib to any other Court of competent jurisdiction at Moga.

2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that applicant is residing with her parents at Moga. She has one minor daughter to look after. She has no source of income and it is very difficult for her to travel 80 kms from Sri Muktsar Sahib to Moga to attend the proceedings on each date of hearing.

3. Notice of motion was issued to the respondent for today, but no one has put in appearance on his behalf despite service to assist this court.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the applicant and have gone through the record of the case.

5. Learned counsel for the applicant also relies upon judgment of Hon'ble Apex Court in case titled ***Sumita Singh Vs. Kumar Sanjay and another, AIR 2002 SC 396***, wherein it is held that transfer of matrimonial proceedings initiated by the husband against wife, convenience of the wife ought to be looked into.

6. In the premise, present application is allowed. The petition in question pending before the Court of Civil Judge (Senior Division), Sri Muktsar Sahib is ordered to be withdrawn from that Court and is transferred to the District Judge, Moga for its disposal in accordance with law by the Court concerned.
