Learned State counsel, on instructions states that since the petitioner has joined the investigation and has been released on interim bail as per orders of this Court and no recovery is to be effected from the petitioner, as such, his custodial interrogation is not required.

It being so, the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 23.10.2019 is made absolute, subject to the following conditions:-

- 1.That the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
- 2.That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;
- 3.That he shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.

4.He shall surrender his passport before the Investigating Officer and if he is not having passport, then, shall file the affidavit in that regard.

In case, the petitioner violate any terms & conditions, on which the bail has been granted to him, the prosecution would be entitled to apply for cancellation of bail.

The petition stands allowed accordingly.
