Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.64 dated 10.10.2019 under Sections 186 and 353 IPC, registered at Police Station Sekhwan, District Batala. They apprehended their arrest at the hands of Police in the above said FIR.

On 24.10.2019, notice of motion was issued and the petitioners were directed to join the investigation and the said order reads as under:

“Notice of motion for 16.03.2020.

Meanwhile, the petitioners shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be admitted to interim bail on their furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioners shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by SI Jaspal Singh has apprised the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation. She

further states that after completion of investigation, a cancellation report has been prepared, which is yet to be filed before the Court.

In view of above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and is disposed off as such.
