The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail, pending trial, in case FIR No.182, dated 01.07.2019, registered under Sections 323, 285, 365, 427, 452, 34, 216, 506 and 325 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Salhawass, District Jhajjar.

2. Heard.

3. Reply by way of affidavit of HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, HQ., Jhajjar on behalf of the respondent filed today in the Court; Be kept on the record. A copy of the same be supplied to the counsel opposite.

4. It transpires from the reply that the injuries suffered by the victim in the present case were actually simple in nature although there is

an allegation that the petitioner had tried to run over his vehicle on the said victim. Another victim, namely, Rajbir, who was allegedly sought to be kidnapped has, in his affidavit, exonerated the petitioner and the said affidavit is a part of the Police record.

5. Apart from this matter, the petitioner has been implicated in as many as 14 other cases. The list of which has been mentioned in the affidavit, but he has already been acquitted in 09 of those while trial is pending in other 05 cases. All other accused persons in the present case are already on bail.

6. Considering the overall circumstances, detention of the petitioner in the present case, at this stage, would not serve any purpose. Therefore, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner, namely, **Sandeep**, is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
