In compliance of order dated 24.01.2020, learned counsel for the petitioner has produced receipts of ₹20,000/-. The same are taken on record.

Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No.68 dated 06.05.2015, registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, at Police Station Model Town, District Ludhiana (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Pursuant to order dated 29.10.2019 of a Coordinate Bench, the parties appeared before the trial Court on 25.11.2019 to get their statements recorded.

Learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana, has submitted his report vide letter bearing No.2193 dated 26.11.2019,

duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Ludhiana,
vide Endst. No.941/EC dated 04.12.2019.

According to the above report, compromise entered into
between the parties is genuine and without any pressure, coercion or
undue influence.

Therefore, in view of above and the fact that the
compromise will bring peace and harmony between the parties, FIR
No.68 dated 06.05.2015, registered under Sections 420, 465, 467,
468, 471, 120-B IPC, at Police Station Model Town, District Ludhiana
(Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom,
are quashed.

Disposed of accordingly.

Registry shall verify the deposit of costs by the petitioners
with the quarters concerned.
