Applicant-wife seeks transfer of petition filed by the respondent-Husband under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act titled as “Sandeep Singh vs. Gurcharanpreet Kaur” from the Court of Ld.Principal Judge, Family Courts, Amritsar to the competent Court at Tarn Taran.

2. Notice of motion was issued to the respondent for today, i.e. 06.01.2020. Office report reveals that the respondent refused to accept the notice and affixation thereof was made.

3. I have heard learned counsel for the applicant and have gone through the record of the case.

4. The petition filed by the respondent-husband at Amritsar seeking dissolution of marriage is outcome of matrimonial dispute arisen

between the parties. It has come on record that FIR No.149 dated 16.12.2017 under Section 498-A, 406, 420, 376, 511 has also been registered at the instance of applicant-wife at P.S. Chohla Sahib, District Tarn Taran. Considering the aforesaid aspects of the matter it would be appropriate and in the interest of petitioner wife, if the petition in question is transferred to the Court at Tarn Taran.

5. The present application is accordingly allowed. The petition in question is ordered to be withdrawn from the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Amritsar and is transferred to the competent Court at District Tarn Taran.

6. Record of the case be sent to the District Judge, Tarn Taran for its assignment to the Court concerned for disposal in accordance with law.
