On 24.10.2019, the following order was passed:-

"It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is wrongly involved in the case. Further it is submitted that even nobody is alleged to have been injured in the incident at all. The petitioner was granted the concession of interim anticipatory bail. However, the petitioner being a juvenile at that time and his father having expired in the mean-time, the petitioner could not join the investigation. Accordingly, his interim anticipatory bail was rejected by the Court below; for non-joining of the investigation. It is further submitted that the petitioner shall join the investigation now.

Notice of motion for 05.03.2020.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds/surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.."

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in pursuance of above said order, petitioner has joined the investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the aforesaid fact.

In view of the above, the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 24.10.2019, is made absolute.
