In compliance of orders dated 28.01.2020 and 12.02.2020, learned counsel for the petitioners has produced receipts of ₹20,000/-. The same are taken on record.

Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No.46 dated 25.06.2019, registered under Sections 419, 420, 468, 465, 466, 467, 471, 120-B IPC, at Police Station Fatehgarh Churian, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur. (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Pursuant to order dated 14.11.2019 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court on 04.12.2019 to get their statements recorded.

Learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Batala, has submitted his report vide letter bearing No.316 dated 16.12.2019, duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Muktsar, vide Endst. No.21841/RKT dated 17.12.2019.

According to the above report, compromise entered into between the parties is genuine and is not the result of any pressure or coercion.

Therefore, in view of above and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony between the parties, FIR No.46 dated 25.06.2019, registered under Sections 419, 420, 468, 465, 466, 467, 471, 120-B IPC, at Police Station Fatehgarh Churian, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur. (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed.

Disposed of accordingly.

Registry shall verify the deposit of costs by the petitioners with the quarters concerned.
