Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in second attempt in case bearing FIR No.341 dated 14.09.2018 registered under Sections 409, 420, 465, 466, 467, 468, 471 IPC and Sections 13(1(a) and 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 at P.S. Civil Lines, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar.

Earlier petition i.e. CRM-M No.43672 of 2018 was dismissed on merits vide order dated 29.11.2018 passed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that at the time of disposal of the first petition, the FSL report was not available and the same has been received only after dismissal

of the first petition. FSL report does not advance the case of the prosecution conclusively against the petitioner.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties, I do not see that the FSL report alone would give rise to any such consideration favourable to the petitioner, particularly when her previous petition was dismissed on merits.

In view of above, no ground is made out to consider the prayer for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner on second occasion. The petition stands dismissed.
