Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing of FIR No. 167, dated 25.10.2018, registered under Sections 452, 323, 324, 341, 506, 34 IPC 1860 and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Chajjli, District Sangrur and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise given in the form of affidavits dated 17.9.2019 and 18.9.2019 (Annexure P-2 and P-3) effected in between the parties.

Pursuant to orders dated 23.1.2020 of this Court, the parties appeared before Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Sunam, on 13.2.2020 to get their statements recorded. Learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Sunam submitted his report vide letter No. 483 dated 15.2.2020 duly forwarded by the learned District and Sessions Judge, Sangrur, vide Endorsement No.

1478 dated 18.2.2020.

According to the report, learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Sunam, is satisfied that compromise effected between the parties is genuine one, without any pressure or out of their own will.

In compliance of order dated 23.1.2020, original receipts regarding deposit of costs of Rs. 20,000/- have also been produced in Court today. The same are taken on record. Be tagged at appropriate place.

Considering the report of Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Sunam dated 15.2.2020 and deposit of costs as well as the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony between the parties, aforesaid FIR No. 167 dated 25.10.2018 (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed, qua the petitioners only.

Registry is directed to verify deposit of aforesaid costs, with the concerned quarter.

Disposed of, accordingly.
