The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 104 dated 27.09.2019, registered under Sections 336, 452, 323, 34 of the IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Sadar Abohar, District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners, in pursuance to the order dated 24.10.2019, have already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Gurmail Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for any further investigation. It is further submitted that even the matter stands compromised between the parties.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 24.10.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
