Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.118 dated 28.09.2019 registered under Sections 406, 498-A of IPC at Police Station Machhiwara, District Ludhiana.

Vide order dated 24.10.2019, while issuing notice of motion in the case, arrest of the petitioner was stayed and the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and the parties were directed to appear there on 20.11.2019.

Pursuant thereto, parties have appeared before the Mediator and a report dated 09.01.2020 has been received to the effect that the matter has been resolved between the parties and a settlement/agreement has been reduced into writing on 09.01.2020. The said settlement/agreement dated 09.01.2020 shall form part of the record.

Considering the fact that the matter has been settled between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, the order dated 24.10.2019 whereby arrest of the petitioner was stayed, is made absolute.

However, in case the petitioner is required in the case in any manner, a clear 15 days notice shall be given to him.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
