bail in FIR No.195 dated 02.10.2019, registered at Police Station City Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, under Sections 420, 506 and 120-B IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to the order dated 29.10.2019 passed in CRM-M-45848-2019 and dated 18.11.2019 passed in CRM-M-48895-2019 by a Coordinate Bench, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhpal Singh, submits that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for any further investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant states that the transaction took place in 2014, but the compromise was effected in 2015 by pressurizing the complainant to sign the compromise telling that petitioner-Sandeep Bansal had been admitted in the hospital.

Looking to the circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, both the petitions are allowed and the orders dated 29.10.2019 passed in CRM-M-45848-2019 and dated 18.11.2019 passed in CRM-M-48895-2019, granting interim bail to the petitioners, are made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
