The matter has been taken up through video conferencing
in the light of COVID-19 pandemic.

The petitioners herein are labourers, who are migrated from Jammu & Kashmir. It is stated that they were temporarily given accommodation in government buildings. The petitioners apprehending their eviction from the same, have come up in this writ petition seeking direction to the first respondent-Union Territory of Chandigarh, to provide them regular accommodation or to regularize their stay in the present accommodation. Learned counsel appearing for Union Territory, Chandigarh, would submit that similar writ petition was filed by persons, who were similarly placed, in CWP-31458-2019 in the matter of “*Joy George and others Vs. U.T., Chandigarh and others*”, wherein Coordinate Bench of this Court disposed of the said writ petition by order dated 04.09.2020, thereby

reserving liberty to the petitioner to make representation to the Union Territory, Chandigarh. Therefore, learned counsel for respondent-Union Territory, Chandigarh, would submit that this writ petition also may be disposed of on similar terms. After going through the records, it is seen that the petitioners herein were also co-applicants before Union Territory, Chandigarh, in representation dated 22.07.2019, vide Annexure P-3. In the aforesaid circumstance, we find it appropriate to dispose of this writ petition on similar terms of CWP-31458-2019, reserving liberty to the petitioners to pursue the application made by them vide Annexure P-3 and the respondent-Union Territory, Chandigarh, to take necessary decision thereon, within a period of four weeks from that date.

With such observation, this writ petition is disposed of.
