The petitioner herein has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 70 dated 11.2.2019, under Sections 304-B, 498-A and 34 IPC (during investigation Section 498-A and Section 34 IPC stands deleted by the Investigating Agency) registered at Police Station City Tohana, District Fatehabad.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case and he is in custody since 27.2.2019. Learned counsel would submit that during investigation, the police recovered a dairy written by the deceased. A reading of the said dairy would reflect that the deceased was a troubled soul and most of the conversation noted therein pertains to the conversation with her mother,

who passed away in the year 2011. It is also argued that the contents of the diary as such does not disclose the ingredients of Section 304-B IPC qua the petitioner, considering the fact that she has written in the diary that her in-laws family were good to her. The trial is likely to take some time. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind bars till the conclusion of the trial. He prays that the petitioner be admitted to regular bail.

Ms. Mahima Yashpal, AAG, Haryana has opposed the bail, while submitting that the petitioner herein is the only person accused under the said section and the deceased had died within one year of her marriage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without going into the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the investigation is complete and the trial is likely to take some time to conclude, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
