The petitioner has filed present petition for quashing of FIR No.239 dated 09.11.2001 registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Division No.4, Jalandhar and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

The above-said FIR was lodged on statement of Parveen Kumar Mehta on the averments that accused-Akshay Kumar @ Bablu, who had purchased the Maruti car in question by taking loan from Countryvide Finance Company, forged Registration Certificate showing number PB08-AC-4370 to be that of the above-said car but which in fact pertained to Scooter and fraudulently sold the same to the complainant for Rs.1,70,000/- by executing requisite documents including the affidavit.

The petitioner has filed the present petition for quashing of the FIR on the grounds that now with the intervention of respectables, the matter has been amicably compromised between the parties and they have resolved their differences.

On realising that FIR involves offences of public character having social impart which is not liable to be quashed on the basis of compromise, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks dismissal of the petition as withdrawn.
