Counsel for the appellant would state that brief has been taken back by the appellant. He is not prepared to make submissions despite last opportunity granted vide orders dated 26.3.2019 and 10.7.2019. A relevant extract from order dated 10.7.2019 reads as follows:-

“ A perusal of the order sheets reveals that the present appeal, which was filed in the year 2017, has been repeatedly adjourned either on the request made by learned counsel for the appellants or for his non-appearance. Even today, there is no appearance on behalf of learned counsel for the appellants.

In the interest of justice and subject to payment of Rs. 5,000/- as costs to be deposited with the Poor Patient Welfare Fund, PGIMER, Chandigarh, another opportunity is granted to learned counsel for the appellants to address arguments.

Adjourned to 4.2.2020.

It is clarified that if on the adjourned date, no arguments are addressed, the appeal shall be deemed to have been dismissed for non-prosecution.

A copy of the order be communicated to learned counsel for the appellants.”

It is obligation of the appellant to ensure representation on her behalf and make submissions in compliance with orders passed by the Court. Even counsel for the appellant has not complied with order with regard to payment of costs of Rs. 5000/-.
