This order shall decide CWP Nos.7631 of 2014 and CWP No.15603 of 2015 as point in issue in both the cases is same.

2. Prayer in the writ petitions is for the issuance of a writ of Certiorari for quashing order Annexure P-14 dated 17.12.2013 passed by respondent No.4 rejecting the claim of the petitioners for grant of pay scale of ₹2200-4000 from the date of joining and corresponding revised pay scale of ₹8000-13500 w.e.f. 1.1.1996 and further for the issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to grant pay scale of ₹2200-4000 from the date of joining of the petitioners and also the corresponding revised pay scale of ₹8000-13500 w.e.f. 1.1.1996 to the petitioners in accordance with the

decision of the Executive Council of the M.D.U Rohtak Annexure P-2 dated 09.12.1993 and Annexure P-5 dated 20.02.2002 alongwith all consequential benefits.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the grievance which is the subject matter of the writ petitions has been addressed by the State of Haryana by passing order Annexure P-15 dated 13.11.2014 on representation submitted after the admission of the writ petitions, however, the petitioners have not been released the benefits as per the entitlement so determined vide order Annexure P-15 solely on account of pendency of the writ petitions.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents do not dispute the passing of order Annexure P-15.

5. In view of the position as noted above, the writ petitions are disposed of by directing respondent Nos.1 and 2 to consider and decide the claim of the petitioners for release of benefits as per entitlement which is claimed to have been decided vide order Annexure P-15 within a period of 6 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
