Learned counsel for the petitioner, after going through the reply filed on 20.01.2020 on behalf of the respondent-NIA, states that the position of law as contained in Section 21 of the National Investigation Act, 2008, whereby any order passed by the Special Court refusing his bail, is to be challenged by way of an appeal to be heard by a Division Bench of the High Court. He, therefore, wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh one in accordance with law.

3. Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is also noted to the effect that the present petition was filed within the stipulated period of limitation after passing of the impugned order.
