Present appeal has been filed for setting aside the impugned judgment and decree dated 08.11.2017, passed by learned Additional District Judge, Barnala, affirming the judgment and decree dated 01.08.2014 of learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Barnala, whereby the suit filed by the appellants/plaintiffs for declaration, possession and permanent injunction restraining the respondent Nos.1 to 4/defendant(s) from alienating the land as fully described therein has been dismissed.

This Court, on 22.04.2019, passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the appellants seeks short accommodation to address arguments. There was already last opportunity granted.

In the interest of justice, hearing of appeal is deferred to 01.08.2019, subject to plantation of 25 neem saplings at the place from where the appeal arose, purchased from the concerned Horticulture Department or Forest Department. Receipt of purchase of saplings and compliance report with regard to plantation shall be produced at the next date of hearing, failing which the appeal shall be dismissed for non compliance.”

Learned Counsel for the appellants has fairly stated that she has no instructions in terms of above order dated 22.04.2019, passed by this Court.

In view of above, the present appeal is dismissed for non-prosecution.
