Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.280 dated 24.09.2019 under Sections 323, 406 and 498-A IPC registered at Police Station Dabwali Sadar, District Sirsa.

Vide order dated 02.11.2019 passed by this Court, while staying the arrest of the petitioner, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, where the petitioner and respondent No.2 were directed to appear on 20.11.2019.

A report dated 09.01.2020 has been received from the Mediator, wherein it is mentioned that the mediation is successful and the matter has

been compromised between the parties vide settlement agreement dated 09.01.2020.

In view of the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties before the Mediator, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 02.11.2019 whereby arrest of the petitioner was stayed by this Court, is made absolute.

The parties shall adhere to the terms of the settlement agreement dated 09.01.2020.

However, in case the petitioner is required in the case in any manner, a clear 15 days notice shall be served upon him.
