taken on record subject to just exceptions.

Disposed of accordingly.

Prayer in this application filed under Order 23 Rule 3 read
with Section 151 CPC is for recording compromise dated 12.02.2020
arrived at between the parties and to pass a decree in view of the
compromise.

Original compromise deed dated 12.02.2020 between Gurtinder Pal Singh – appellant and Lakhwinder Singh – respondent No.1 in RSA No.5909 of 2018 produced in the Court is taken on record.

Counsel for the parties, on instructions from Gurtinder Pal Singh and Lakhwinder Singh present in the Court, would state that dispute between the contesting parties has been settled by way of compromise. It is further submitted that respondents No.2 and 3 namely Ranjit Kaur and Jasbir Kaur are not the contesting parties and they have not claimed any right in the suit property. Counsel would pray that RSA No.5909 of 2018 may be taken on board, decree and judgment passed by the Appellate Court may be set aside and that of the trial Court may be restored.

In view of the above, the application is allowed. RSA No.5909 of 2018 is taken on board and stands disposed of in view of compromise dated 12.02.2020. In consequence thereof, decree and judgment dated 24.09.2018 passed by the Additional District Judge, Patiala is set aside and that of the trial Court dated 17.02.2016 is restored leaving the parties to bear their own costs. The parties shall remain bound by terms and conditions of compromise.
