TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J. (ORAL)

This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioner who is serving on the post of Junior Assistant, Municipal Corporation, SAS Nagar, Mohali filed the instant petition seeking a writ of mandamus for directing the respondent-authorities to reinstate him and to set aside the order of suspension dated 01.12.2017 (Annexure P-1). Further challenge was to the charge sheet dated 20.02.2018 (Annexure P-3).

Counsel for the petitioner informs the Court that during the pendency of the instant writ petition the order of suspension has been revoked and petitioner has been reinstated w.e.f. 28.09.2020.

Insofar as the second prayer assailing the charge-sheet dated

20.02.2018 (Annexure P-3), statement is made that petitioner would not be pressing the instant prayer and liberty be granted to him to raise all submissions/contentions in his defence to the articles of charge formulated at the appropriate stage and before the appropriate authority.

The prayer afore-noticed is allowed.

In view of the above, nothing survives for adjudication in the instant petition.

Petition is disposed of as infructuous.

Pending application, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
