Petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 to 4 to direct respondent Nos.5 to 6 that the presence of the petitioner may be secured only through process of law by serving notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. and to conduct fair investigation in the complaint filed by private respondents.

On 05.11.2019, State counsel was directed to verify the facts as pleaded. In response to the said order, an affidavit of Ashwini Gotyal IPS, Assistant Superintendent of Police City-I, District SAS Nagar (Mohali) on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 5 has been filed, wherein it is pointed out that on a complaint bearing No.3639/Peshi/SSP/SAS Nagar dated 02.09.2019 was made by Javed Ahmed-respondent No.7 against petitioner Aslam Khan and his friend Davinder Kumar Sharma. After inquiry, an FIR No.96 dated 21.11.2019, under Sections 406, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Naya Gaon was registered against the petitioner and

Davinder Kumar Sharma and the present petitioner was arrested on

27.11.2019 in that FIR.

In view of above, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petition is rendered infructuous.

The petition is disposed off as such.
