The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 3 to take legal action against the accused in view of representation dated 14.10.2019 submitted in the office of Senior Superintendent of Police, Rupnagar.

Mr. Rahul Deswal, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.4 and filed his power of attorney which is taken on record.

Learned State Counsel has filed status report on behalf of respondent No.2 by way of affidavit of Sh. Kuldeep Singh Chahal, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

In the status report, Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar (Mohali) has submitted that in the course of enquiry respondent No.4 stated that neither he had detained the driver of the truck nor kept the truck of the petitioner forcibly and he had asked the petitioner to

take his truck and pay damages to him in lieu of damages caused to his goods due to negligence of the driver. Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar (Mohali) has further submitted that the petitioner was asked to take away truck from the premises of respondent No.4 and respondent No.4 was asked to pursue his claim for damages as per law.

In view of the status report and release of the truck, learned Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petition may be disposed of as having become infructuous.

Accordingly, the petition is disposed of as having become infructuous with liberty to the parties to pursue their remedies in accordance with law.
