The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.148, dated 21.08.2019, registered under Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar.

2. Heard.

3. During trial, the complainant, namely, Pritam Singh, has not given any incriminating statement against the petitioner, nor the other prosecution witnesses have made any statement against the petitioner.

4. Even in the original FIR, it was mentioned that the complainant “believe” that his daughter had died due to beating by the petitioner.

5. Considering the overall circumstances, detention of the petitioner in the present case, at this stage, would not serve any purpose. Therefore, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner, namely, **Balwinder Singh @ Binda**, is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
