Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in a complaint case No.285 of 2017 titled '*Charan Kaur vs. Ajmer Singh and others*' under Sections 302/120-B/148/149 IPC.

Vide order 14.11.2019, the order dated 07.11.2019 passed by this Court was rectified and the petitioner was ordered to be released on interim bail till the next date of hearing on his furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

On 28.01.2020, service of respondent No.2 could not be effected for want of paper book. On filing of process fee, the

process was ordered to be issued and the case was adjourned for today.
