Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for quashing of FIR No.285 dated 23.10.2019 under Section 365 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Amritsar, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners have falsely been implicated in the case. Even respondent No.3-Anchal, who is wife of respondent No.2-Veer Singh has given an affidavit to the effect that she left the company of respondent No.2-Veer Singh at her own wishes and sweet will and she is residing with petitioner No.1-Harpreet Singh, who has never pressurized or threatened her to take with him, but this fact is not being considered by the police during investigation.

Notice of motion to respondent No.1 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Hittan Nehra, Addl. A.G. Punjab,

accepts notice on behalf of official respondent No.1.

Let requisite number of copies of paper-book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

Without observing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of, with a direction that in case the petitioners submits a representation giving details of showing their innocence in the case before the SHO concerned, where the FIR has been registered, the same would be considered by the investigating officer in accordance with law.
