The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 4.7.2019 Annexure P/1 passed in CWP No. 6730 of 2018.

Reply has been filed stating therein that there is no such policy of the Government under which the regularization of the petitioners can be considered. Ms. Anu Pal, DAG, Punjab further states that the order to the said effect has been passed.

In view of the same, no further orders are required to be passed in the present contempt petition. The same is rendered infructuous and is dismissed as such.

Rule issued against the respondent(s) is discharge.

However, it is clarified that the said order be supplied to the petitioners/counsel for the petitioners within one week from today which the petitioners will be at liberty to challenge the same in accordance with law. In case the said order is not supplied to the petitioners/counsel for the petitioners within one week, the petitioners will be at liberty to revive the present contempt petition.
