This order shall dispose of CRM-M-47370-2019 and 4253-2020, filed by petitioners Lovepreet @ Bobby and Lovepreet @ Bobby, under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in a case arising from FIR No.0068 dated 18.07.2019, registered under Sections 379-B, 482, 411, 34 IPC, at Police Station Division No.3, District Jalandhar.

According to prosecution on 18.07.2019, petitioners on a motorcycle, snatched away the mobile phone of complainant Manav.

Learned counsel *inter alia* contends that petitioners are in custody since 18.07.2019. No recovery has to be effected from them. Conclusion of trial may take a sufficient long time. No useful purpose would be served by detaining the petitioners any more in jail.

On the other hand, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Rajveer Singh, refuting the above submissions, vehemently opposed the grant of bail to petitioners, submitting that both the petitioners have been identified by the complainant in Court. They have committed a heinous crime. Such type of crimes are increasing day by day. In case, the petitioners are granted the concession of regular bail, they would again commit more offence of similar nature.

Considering the heinous offence, committed by petitioners, they do not deserve any concession of bail.

Both the petitions stand dismissed accordingly.
