Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.77 dated 19.10.2016, registered at Police Station Kotbhai, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, under Sections 302, 307, 379, 436, 336, 427, 324, 323, 148, 149 and 120-B IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the present petitioner is not named in the FIR. He has been nominated as accused on the statement of injured. The petitioner has been in custody since 09.11.2017.

On the other hand, learned State counsel while opposing the prayer made in the present petition, submits that injured-Gurdeep has specifically stated that the present petitioner was armed with a pistol.

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Singh, does not dispute the period of detention of the petitioner.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Challan has already been presented in the present case. The petitioner has been in custody since 09.11.2017. The trial of the case would take time to conclude. Therefore, no useful purpose would be served by keeping him behind the bars.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
