Through the instant petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.146 dated 30.08.2019, registered at Police Station City Patti, District Tarn Taran, under Sections 323, 326, 506 and 34 IPC.

On 07.11.2019, this Court passed the following order:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that as per the prosecution, the present petitioner has given a datar blow near the left elbow of the complainant. It is a case of version and cross-version. The other party has also caused injuries to the sister-in-law of the petitioner.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to join the investigation and if he is sought to be arrested, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer subject to the conditions as envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 07.11.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Satnam Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Looking to the circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 07.11.2019, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
