Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is to seek direction to take action against respondents No.1 and 2 for their failure to decide the representation dated 18.05.2017 (Annexure P-2) and complaint dated 03.03.2017 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the daughter of the petitioner, for having been continuously harassed and mentally tortured by respondent No.5.

No one is present on behalf of the petitioner.

The affidavit dated 24.05.2019 submitted by the Superintendent of Police, Kurukshetra reveals that for giving false information with intention to cause police/public servant to use his lawful power to injure the girl and her family, an appropriate action under Section 182 IPC has been taken against respondent No.5 and a kalandra to that effect has been filed in the competent court by the police through SHO Babain.

In view of above, since the police has already initiated action against respondent No.5, nothing survives in the present petition and the same is accordingly, disposed of.
