The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.48 dated 05.09.2019, registered under Sections 22, 29 of the NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Tallewal, District Barnala.

2. Heard both sides.

3. As per record, admittedly, no recovery was made from the petitioner directly. His name has transpired from the statement of the main accused, namely, Amandeep Singh and the petitioner is also not reported to be involved in any other similar case under the NDPS Act.

4. In the given circumstances, the petition is allowed and the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating

Officer. However, he shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
