The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from harassment at the hands of respondents No.6 and 7.

Reply filed by respondents No.1 to 3. In the reply respondents No.1 to 3 have stated that respondent No.6-Gurjeet Singh had submitted complaint No.4035-DCP dated 01.10.2019 alleging that petitioners No.1 and 2 and husband of petitioner No.1 had taken an amount of Rs.20 lakhs from him and had not returned the same while in counter-blast to the said complaint, petitioner No.1 made complaint No.4315-DCP dated 15.10.2019 alleging therein that respondents No.6-Gurjeet Singh and respondent No.7-Neera Kailey tried to kidnap her children. On enquiry, both the complainants have been closed.

This factual position is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioners who submits that now there is no apprehension as no

complaint is pending before the police.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as no further action is required to be taken on the same.

However, the petitioners shall be at liberty to seek protection of their life and liberty in case of apprehension of any danger by them from respondents No.6 and 7.
