1. Applicant-wife seeks transfer of petition filed by the respondent-husband under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, titled as “Navjot Chandi Vs. Romandeep Kaur Thind” pending in the Court of Civil Judge, Senior Division, Kapurthala to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Jalandhar.

2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that FIR under Sections 406, 498-A of IPC against the respondent is pending at Police Station Women, Police Commissionerate, Jalandhar and one application under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 is also pending at Jalandhar.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the

applicant-wife is residing with her old age parents at Jalandhar. The distance between Kapurthala and Jalandhar is about 30 Kms. Petitioner is working at Jalandhar. He further submits that respondent is a Police Officer and is presently posted at Kapurthala. Applicant-wife has also moved a complaint against the respondent that he is causing threats to her and a DDR to this effect is also registered and hence the applicant has no place to go to Kapurthala and it is difficult for her to go there on each date of hearing.

4. Despite service, none has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-husband and in the premise, this Court is of the view that respondent-husband is deemed to have consented the present transfer application by not contesting the same.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the applicant and have gone through the record of the case.

6. All the cases pending between the parties are aftermath of matrimonial discord. Keeping in view the contentions in the application and the conceded position that FIR under Sections 406, 498-A of IPC and one application under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 are also pending at Jalandhar it would be proper, appropriate and in the interest of justice if all the cases are tried and decided at one place.

7. In the premise, present application is allowed. The petition in question pending before the Court of Civil Judge, Senior Division, Kapurthala is ordered to be withdrawn from that Court and is transferred to the District Judge, Jalandhar for its

disposal in accordance with law by the Court concerned.
