On 24.10.2019, the following order was passed:-

“Learned counsel for the respondents produced order dated 16.10.2019, by which all the benefits which were being prayed by the petitioner in the present writ petition have already been granted to the petitioner.

As there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner, adjourned to 17.01.2020. However, it is made clear that in case, on the next date of hearing, no one appears on behalf of the petitioner, an appropriate order will be passed without affording any further adjournment.”

Today, learned counsel for the petitioner states that as per his instruction, no amount has been paid, whereas, the order dated 16.10.2019 placed on record shows that the pension withheld vide order dated 25.11.2014 was ordered to be released from the date of withholding.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to release the pension as per the order dated 16.10.2019 placed by the respondents on record from the date he is found due.

In case, the said amount alongwith arrears, if any, is not released within two months from today, the petitioner will be at liberty to revive the present writ petition and the respondents shall also be liable for contempt.
