SUVIR SEHGAL J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.181, dated 13.08.2018 registered under Sections 21 and 22 of NDPS Act at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is disabled person and on his request this Court vide order dated 29.01.2020, directed the State to submit the health status of the petitioner. In pursuance thereto, learned State counsel has filed a medical certificate wherein it has been reported as under:-

“Post polio residual paralysis Both lower limbs

Disability-100% Hundred

Permanent”

Learned State counsel has submitted that the challan was presented on 06.05.2019 and the charges are yet to be framed. He has opposed the bail application on the ground that recovery from the

petitioner was of heavy quantity.

Heard.

Considering the medical condition of the petitioner noticed above, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
