The instant Petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking Regular Bail on behalf of the Petitioner in case FIR No.417, dated 27th June, 2019, registered under Sections 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Sections 212, 120-B of the IPC added later on) and Sections 25/54 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Sector-7, Faridabad.

2. Supplementary Reply to the Bail Application has been sent up on behalf of the State by E-mail, today; Be kept on record.

3. With reference to the observation noted in the Para No.6 of the last order, Ld. Counsel for the Petitioner submits that the Petitioner was seen along with other accused persons in the CCTV Footage pertaining to

the Accent Car bearing Registration No.HR69-C-0638 which was got fueled up at the Petrol Pump at Sonepat from where it went on to the place of occurrence in Faridabad.

4. This, in view of the Court, is reasonably sufficient material to indicate involvement of the Petitioner in the conspiracy to murder the Victim on the relevant date.

5. This Court therefore finds no ground to release the Petitioner on bail at this stage.

6. Dismissed.
