Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.252 dated 24.07.2019 registered under Sections 379, 411, 420, 467, 468, 471, 413, 414, 201, 120-B IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Murthal, District Sonapat.

It is not in dispute that in compliance of order dated 07.11.2019, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from S.I. Subash Chander states that the petitioner is not required for any further investigation of the case.

In view of aforesaid position, interim order dated 07.11.2019 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
