The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.37 dated 12.2.2019, under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Lehra, District Sangrur

On 13.11.2019, while granting concession of interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, the following order was passed:

“Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was granted regular bail and was facing the trial. However, on account of noting of a wrong date, neither the petitioner nor her counsel could appear before the trial Court on 11.10.2019 and her bail/surety bonds were forfeited. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner will appear before the trial Court within a period of 10 days from today and furnish fresh bail/surety bonds.

Notice of motion for 18.12.2019.”

Thereafter, on 18.12.2019, since it was stated that the petitioner could not arrange a surety, the petitioner was granted some more time to

comply with the order dated 13.11.2019 and the case was adjourned for today.

Today, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has still not complied with the order dated 13.11.2019 as she has not surrendered before the trial Court for grant of regular bail.

This fact is not disputed by learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Gurmeet Singh.

In view of the above, this petition is hereby dismissed.
