Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 361 dated 23.07.2019 registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B and 506 IPC, at Police Station Shahabad, District Kurukshetra.

Vide order dated 08.11.2019, interim bail was granted to the petitioner with direction to join the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner went to the Police Station but his statement was not recorded. He further states that he has audio and video recording conversation with investigation officer.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

The assertions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner are not believable and the petitioner has not joined the investigation, even after availing two opportunities.

In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed.

The interim order dated 08.11.2019, granting interim bail to the petitioner stands vacated.
