Rajiv Sharma, J.

The matter was taken up on 14.10.2019. Learned counsel for the petitioners prays for an adjournment to deposit an amount of ₹ 3 lacs (rupees three lacs). The fact of the matter is that there is nothing on record to suggest that the petitioner has deposited ₹ 3 lacs (rupees three lacs) with the respondent-bank. To the contrary, learned counsel for the respondent-bank has submitted that cheque of ₹ 3 lacs (rupees three lacs) deposited in favour of bank was dishonoured.

Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed for non-compliance.
