This order of mine shall dispose of CRM-M-47941-2019, filed by petitioner-Mohit and CRM-M-52327-2019, filed by petitioner-Avinash, under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.121 dated 05.03.2019, registered at Police Station City Jind, District Jind, under Sections 379-A read with Section 34

Learned counsel for the petitioners contend that while appearing into the witness-box, the complainant and her husband have not supported the prosecution version and have resiled from their statements given to the police.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Bhagwat Dayal, opposes the prayer made in the petitions. However, he admits the fact that the complainant and her husband have resiled from their statements given to the police.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned State counsel.

Challan has already been presented. The petitioners have been in custody since 25.07.2019. The trial of the case would take time to conclude. Therefore, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioners behind the bars.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, both the petitions are allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
