Through the instant petition under Section 438 of Criminal Procedure Code, 1973, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 115 dated 29.06.2019 registered under Sections 379-B, 341, 336, 427 IPC, at Police Station City South, District Moga.

Vide order dated 14.11.2019, petitioner was directed to join the investigation in view of grant of interim bail. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to that order passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukhdev Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for any further investigation.
