In compliance of order dated 28.01.2020, learned counsel for the petitioner has produced receipts of ₹20,000/-. The same are taken on record.

Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No.254 dated 11.04.2015, registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 167 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Civil Line Karnal, Haryana and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

Pursuant to order dated 14.11.2019 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court on 28.11.2019 to get their statements recorded.

Learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Karnal, has

submitted his report vide letter bearing No.424 dated 07.12.2019, duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Karnal, vide Endst. No.18044 dated 07.12.2019.

According to the above report, compromise entered into between the parties is genuine and valid and without any pressure or undue influence.

Therefore, in view of above and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony in relations between the parties, FIR No.254 dated 11.04.2015, registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 167 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Civil Line Karnal, Haryana and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are quashed.

Disposed of accordingly.

Registry shall verify the deposit of costs by the petitioners with the concerned quarters.
