Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.170 dated 24.10.2019 under Section 365 IPC, registered at Police Station Cantonment, District Amritsar.

Power of attorney filed on behalf of the complainant today in the Court, is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to the order dated 13.11.2019 passed by this Court, petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sarwan Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation

of the petitioners is no more required at this stage.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 13.11.2019 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
